








TOP 10 places of Shchuchin district De Shchuchin - Rutkevichi - Razhanka - Zhaludok - Muravanka - Ischalna - Staryja Vasilishki - Stary Dvor - Novy Dvor - Kamenka - Shchuchin

The tourist route will introduce you to the most interesting interesting and popular sights of Shchuchin district.

During the tour you will see picturesque landscapes, small settlements with a long history, ancient churches and churches, you will find out what legends and secrets are associated with these places.



"Jewish places of Shchuchin region. Past and present"

The tourist route will go through the places where Jews lived: you will see preserved houses, synagogue buildings, monuments in the Jewish cemetery. In addition, the Shchuchin district was the birthplace of several famous representatives of the creative intelligentsia.

Shchuchin: In the pre-war era, 70% of the population of Schuchin was the Jewish population. City Jews engaged in trade and craft. Currently, only a small part of the heritage related to Jewish life and traditions has been preserved: a former house of worship, urban development, a monument at the site of the mass execution of Jews, a cemetery.

Orlya: In the 19th century, a synagogue operated. The Jewish cemetery has survived.

Zhaludok: Zheludok is one of the oldest settlements in the Shchuchin district with a rich multicultural history and traditions. The Jewish community was formed here in the XVII-XVIII centuries and made up a significant part of the population, which made a great contribution to the economic development of the region. An important advantage of the town is the preserved layout and monuments of Jewish historical and cultural heritage. An important feature is the memory of the "Jewish Zhaludok", people's memories, preserved Jewish houses, a bathhouse, schools, a synagogue, a cemetery, a mikvah.

Vasilishki: In written sources mentioned from the first half of the 15th century. In the 19th century, there were 2 prayer houses. The synagogue building has been preserved, the grave of more than 2 thousand victims of Nazism is located.

Novy Dvor: in the 19th century there were 2 prayer houses, the building of one of them has survived to our time.

Astrina: here pre-war residential buildings, a synagogue, a house of worship have been preserved.

Kamenka: has been known since the 16th century. At the end of the 19th century, there were 2 prayer houses in the town. The Jewish cemetery has survived.
